April 28, 2022

Call to Order: 7:10 PM by David Snodgrass

Reports:

- Secretary
 - Minutes from the March 2022 meeting were reviewed. Motion to approve by David, 2nd by Dean, unanimous approval of the motion

- Treasurer
 - Robin provided written financial reports for review. Reconciled balance as of 3/31/22 is \$66,143.38. Deposits and payments were done for the OMEA District concession event, as well as a payment for the commissioned piece in honor of the new high school

- Band/Auxiliary (Craig)
 - OMEA State contest for Concert Band is April 30 in Newark, some chaperones are needed for the buses
 - Spring concert for Middle School music groups is May 5; for HS music groups spring concert is May 11
 - 15 color guard members were selected from auditions
 - Marching Band is preparing for the Memorial Day parade

- Choir (Lisa)
 - All 3 vocal groups are going to State contest, S/A on April 29 in Newark, T/B and Select at Delaware Hayes on April 30
 - Choir is singing at graduation

Old Business:

- OMEA Middle School Concessions
 - BWHS is only hosting groups on Friday May 13; 25 groups/~1500 students are expected; some groups are arriving at 1:40 although the judging does not begin until 3:30 so we will need to be ready to sell by 2:30; the last group performs at 9:30 PM
 - A SignUp Genius will be going out for volunteers; Robin and Laura are coordinating food purchases; Kelly has contacted Karyl Sharkey from Athletic Boosters re: using the concession stand again; Barb is printing name tags and price lists

- Memorial Day Market
 - To date there are 7 food vendors and 43 non-food vendors confirmed for the event, looking for 1 more food vendor
 - City of Sunbury application for use of the square has been filed; the city is paying for a dumpster
 - Insurance has been obtained
 - David has almost finalized the contract for portable toilets and has contacted the person who has painted lines in the past
 - The Kid's Zone will have 2 inflatables
 - There are signs in the storage shed at the old high school which in the past have been placed around town before Memorial Day; Dean will go to the shed to retrieve the signs on Saturday
 - Robin will make BWMMB buttons for the volunteers to wear on the day of the event
 - Still working on obtaining sponsorships and volunteers to help the day before
 - Laura will create a SignUp Genius for volunteers for the event

New Business:

- Officer elections need to be held in June; David proposed holding the monthly meeting on June 23 off-site and will make arrangements for that
- The new budget year begins on July 1
