Treasurer's Report:

Balance is \$52,664.70 as of 12/31/2018.

The fundraisers on the report are \$132.76 from Whit's and \$2,420.00 from the mattress sale. Kroger and restaurant fundraisers should be labeled as "trip assistance," and which restaurants should be noted.

The Aladdin play income was \$3,030.00 and expense \$3,199.30; the difference should come out of the middle school budget.

Attire and uniform expenses should be combined (attire is band and choir concert wear and uniforms are marching band.)
