Reports:

- Secretary
 - Minutes from the November 18, 2021 meeting were reviewed; no comments or corrections. Motion to approve by Barb, 2nd by Lisa, unanimous approval of the motion.
 - No minutes from December as no meeting was held.

- Treasurer
 - Written financial reports provided by Robin; of note was a deposit of \$500.26 from Kroger Rewards.
 - The IRS issue with 2020 taxes has been resolved.
 - Dean Wolfe has not yet been added to the bank account as a co-signer, he and Robin will arrange a time to complete this soon.

- Band/Auxiliary (Craig)
 - The final concert at the old high school was held in December.
 - OMEA solo & ensemble competition is Saturday January 22 at Granville HS.
 - A student teacher from Ohio State is working with Craig this semester.

- Choir (Lisa)
 - A student teacher from Ohio University is working with Lisa this semester.
 - One student was selected to perform with the All State Choir at the OMEA convention in February.

Old Business:

- Craig has spoken with Big Walnut Apparel, they will handle a spirit wear sale for us.

New Business:

- BWHS is the second site host for OMEA State Competition on March 4 & 5, the Music Boosters will operate a concession stand both days to sell food and drinks to attendees; Craig has a binder of necessary information for planning the event.
- BWHS will also host the Middle School OMEA Competition on May 13 & 14.
- The Music Boosters plan the Sunbury Memorial Day Flea Market, planning will need to commence soon and vendors contacted; Craig has a binder of all information needed

Other Business:

- Dave asked Craig and Lisa for their thoughts on future capital improvement projects
 - New drumline equipment for marching band, projected to cost \$10-\$12,000; Craig is aware of the possibility of acquiring drum equipment from Columbus Percussion at a discount - it was used in the recent Rose Bowl Parade.
 - A larger grand piano for the new auditorium.

- The directors are considering a band/choir trip in Fall 2022 or Spring 2023
